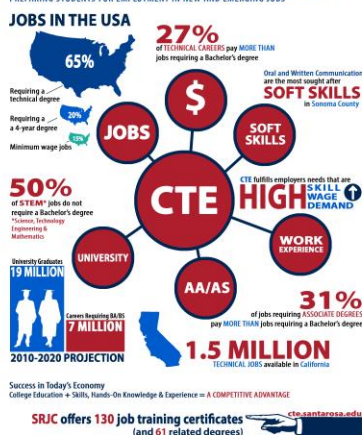
SRJC offers **130** job training certificates (and **61** related degrees).
